Official EU voting records show that in the Council of Ministers the UK government has voted “No” to laws passed at EU level on 56 occasions, abstained 70 times, and voted “Yes” 2,466 times since 1999. UK ministers were on the winning side 95% of the time, abstained 3% of the time and were on the losing side 2%. These laws were passed jointly with the European Parliament. The idea that laws are imposed on us by an undemocratic European Commission is simply not true.
